15. **Chateau Mayne-Vieil, Fronsac France** £30.00  
Classic Merlot-based claret, quite full-bodied with a homely charm. With classic grilled meats or a casserole.


16. **St Emilion, Chateau Lucas** £30.00  
From gently sloping hills around village of St Emilion, famous from Roman times.  
Smooth medium bodied red.

17. **Fleurie, Charles Vienot** £30.00  
The village of Fleurie is situated in the North of the Beaujolais region.  
The vineyards here have a perfect aspect in relation to the sun.

18. **Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Louis Latour** £28.00  
Beautiful bright ruby color. The nose offers undergrowth and red fruits aromas.  
The palate is round with vibrant fruity notes of blackcurrant, morello cherry and liquorice.  
The tannins are silky.

19. **Cotes du Rhone, Rouge Bassot** £26.00

20. **Tempus Two 'Silver Series' Merlot (Aus)** £26.00  
Aromas of Plum, hints of chocolate and cigar-box characters. A full-bodied, with fine tannins and ripe, berry fruit flavours balanced by earthiness and spice.
21. **Vallicergo Rioja Red (Spain)** £27.00  
Smooth fruity medium bodied Crianza red, with lots of vanilla and spice on the finish.
22. **Moko Black Pinot Noir (N.Z)** £26.00  
Fresh, cool bright and breezy with a silky finish.
23. **The Listening Station Malbec (Aus)** £26.00  
Intense ripe blackcurrant aromas with aromatic spices of clove and vanilla.
30. **Oude Kaap Reserve Shiraz (S.A)** £26.00


